In doing so, you may build relationships with the person supported and their friends and family. You may also learn new things about yourself in the process. You need to be flexible, understanding, organized, open-minded and welcoming. You need to celebrate diversity. You need to be a problem-solver, and a good communicator with a sense of humour.

Your role is to provide safe care and support to the individual in a non-judgmental, inclusive environment. You are responsible for the safety, health, and well-being of the person supported while they are in your care, and for making sure, that person has the opportunity for personal and social development both inside and outside of your home.

You will report directly to the Respite Coordinator.

Hours and Compensation:

- Days to be discussed with the family.
- \$150 for a 24 hour period.

Qualifications:

- Be over the age of 19
- Have an updated Criminal Record Check
- Current First Aid Certificate
- Successfully complete the requirements for Lifetime Networks on-boarding process
- Please note that if you provide respite in your own home, each individual in the home who is over the age of 19 must also have an updated Criminal Record Check
